



SALUTE!

Goal: Players guess the card they have using the sum as clue

Skill: Addition, Number Sense

Players: 3

Materials: Deck of cards with Js, Qs, Ks removed

Setup & Gameplay:

1. Players sit in a circle, players take turns being the Judge.
2. Judge gives each player a card, face down.
3. When the Judge says "Salute!", the players without looking at the card in their hand, put it up on the forehead so others can see it.
4. The judge then announces - "The sum of the two cards is..." and the sum.
5. First player to correctly guess the card they are holding is the winner of that round.
6. Game continues until all players have had a turn being the judge.

Example:

The judge announces the sum to be 13.

Player 1 sees that player 2 is showing a 7.

Player 1 deduces that they have a 6.

Variation:

This game can be played with multiplication. E.g.: The judge announces the product to be 20. Player 2 sees that player 1 is showing a 5, player 2 deduces that they have a 4.
