

MATERIALS:

- *Scissors
- *Piece of paper
- *Pencil

This is an activity where the teacher performs a little “math magic” by taking an ordinary piece of paper and cutting it in such a way that it become a large “circle” that kids can walk through.

Back in the classroom, use the Step-Through Circle instructions to demonstrate to the class how one cuts through an ordinary piece of paper.

After creating the circle, give the detectives a chance to walk through it.

At the end of the day, pass out a **Step-Through Circle** sheet to each detective. They can take the sheets home and cut them out with the help of an adult.
