Hello Wonderful Zeno Partners!

It is our goal to continue to spark joy and inspire a love of math. Families can engage their children in each math concept before they even receive their games! Let's explore the math concept of Spatial Awareness.

Spatial Awareness Activities

- When putting away groceries, dishes, laundry, etc. talk about where the different items belong using position words.
- While eating meals, talk about the location of food on the plate. For example, "My oranges are NEXT TO my sandwich."
- When playing with your child talk about positions in your child's play. For example, "I see you knocked the blocks down and now they are ON TOP of the dolls."
- Talk about where you are searching (under, behind, between). For example, "I am looking UNDER the bed."
- Play "I-Spy" with your child using position words. For example, "I spy something blue that is INSIDE a box."
- When it comes time to clean up our toys use position words to put toys away. For example, "I am putting the LEGO bin BELOW the dolls." or "Do the crayons go BESIDE the shelf of IN the cabinet?"
