

Connecting with Number Recognition

Hello Wonderful Zeno Partners!

It is our goal to continue to spark joy and inspire a love of math. Families can engage their children in each math concept before they even receive their games! Let's explore the math concept of Number Recognition.

Number Recognition Activities

- Draw many chalk circles on the ground. Write a number in each circle from 1 to 10. Call out a number and have your child find a circle with that number inside.
- Go on a number hunt! While on a walk with your child look for numbers along the way. For example, a bus number, numbers on a car, poster, gate, house etc.
- Read stories or books with numbers on the pages with your child and say, "I see the number 5 on this page, can you find 5 of something?"
- While preparing food write a number next to your child plate and have your child place the right number of snacks on their plate. For example, have your child place 3 raspberries next to the number 3.
- Create a linear family picture with your child using the ages of family members to determine the order. The family could be ordered from oldest to youngest or youngest to oldest.
