BECOME A ZENO CHAMPION

What does it mean to be a Zeno Champion?

From guest recruitment to championing Zeno's work in the community, Zeno Champions play a vital role in the success of Zeno's fundraising and engagement events. Zeno Champions support this event in at least one following ways:





- Recruit 5-7 people to attend the Make a Move 4 Math Game Build and Reception on Thursday, May 4,
 2023. Your guests can register for the event by clicking here.
- Share out and have your family, friends, work team members or others in your network contribute to Make a Move 4 Math campaign by making a donation here.

Who should I invite?

Friends, family, or others in your network who are interested in supporting opportunities for children and families of color to experience math in an accessible and culturally relevant way. Though we encourage you to invite 5-7 guests, you are welcome to extend the invitation to more people.

You can reach a wider audience and help spread the news about Zeno's work by inviting friends and loved ones who would not normally be able to attend because they don't live locally to participate virtually by making a donation here.

What do I say?

In this Zeno Champion Toolkit, you will find sample invitation language. We encourage you to share personal anecdotes or stories about Zeno and why you think our work is important. Emphasize the impact you believe Zeno has on the lives of children and families, their communities, and the world.

Follow-up is key! Often, people won't respond to your first email/invitation so follow up by email/phone/text/in-person.

Then follow up again.

What is our attendance goal for this event?

This year, our goal is to have Zeno Champions help us reach 100 guests via our Make a Move 4 Math 2023 campaign. With your support, we can do it!

How do I register as a Champion?

Zeno Champion (Board and Staff) have already been added to the registration and donation forms. However, Champions wanting to attend are still required to <u>register for the MM4M Game Build and Reception</u>. Reference the <u>MM4M 2023_How_To_Register</u> document for step-by-step instructions.

How are registration invites tracked?

Registrants will be promoted to select a champion from the "Invited By:" dropdown list in the "Additional Details" section of the MM4M Game Build and Reception Registration form.

How to donate on my behalf?

Donors will be promoted to select a champion from the "**Donation In Honor Of:**" dropdown list in the "Your Details" section of the **MM4M Donation** form listed on our website.





How else can my friends and family participate if they are unable to attend the 2023 Make a Move 4 Math Game Build and Reception event?

We understand there are many events scheduled during the spring. If your guests cannot attend the gathering, encourage them to consider <u>making a financial gift in lieu of their attendance</u>. All donations are used to support the sustainability and growth of Zeno programs and services.

INVITE GUESTS TO JOIN YOUR VIRTUAL TEAM

How to invite:

- Begin by inviting 15+ people your goal is to bring 5-7 guests. Be ready to hear a few "declines" and don't get discouraged.
- Make it personal! Talk to your guests about Zeno and your experiences at our past events.
- Email your invitation with a personal message letting that guest know you are inviting them to attend.
- Follow up with text messages, emails, voice mails (or all of the above)!

Who to invite:

- Who shares Zeno's vision/values and wants to connect with our cause?
- Who has invited you to a fundraising event or to support their favorite cause?
- Who has the capacity to contribute?
- Who do you do business with?
- Who is part of your family?
- Who is part of your circle of friends, church, social clubs, your child's school community, your neighborhood, etc.?

Final thoughts:

- Don't hesitate because someone might not be able to come to the event. Invite them now. Making them aware of the event this year will create 'buzz' and make them MORE likely to accept your invitation next year!
- If you have friends that you think would make a great Zeno Champion, encourage them to co-lead your team with you or to become a Zeno Champion with their own team.
- It's okay if guests can't attend. Your friends can still join your team by making a gift in lieu of their attendance.
- Keep your deadlines in mind. Help create a warm and welcoming event by providing your guest names to the planning team with as much lead time as possible.
- Have fun! Express your excitement and people will want to join your table.
